

What is Telehealth?

- Telehealth is a virtual appointment with a Provider, which allows assessment and care for your child without an in-person appointment.
- Provider will be able to diagnose illnesses such as, but not limited to, ear infections, cold/flu, fever, bug bites, sinus pain, sore throat, allergies, eye irritants, respiratory issues, rashes, and stomachaches.
- Provider may submit prescriptions to your Pharmacy of choice if needed.
- Parents/Guardians will be contacted during visit and will be able to attend all appointments virtually or in person.

Who is the Provider that will see my child?

- Ashley Hardee is the Jackson Madison County School Health Clinic's Nurse Practitioner and is conveniently located on the JCT School campus.
- If your child goes to the Community Montessori School Nurse and you would like him/her to be seen by a Provider, the nurse will contact you and virtually connect you, your child, and Ashley. Ashley will then use the virtual equipment, Tytocare, to assess and treat your child.

How do I schedule an appointment?
